"I Won't Let Go"- Genesis 32: 22-28.

Who or what are you wrestling with in your life? Sometimes our biggest opponent is ourselves. We wrestle between our moral conscience and mortal flesh -- ultimately, this can result in our wrestling with God.

You should **never** underestimate the on to God, trusting, and never letting go. As ludicrous as it may sound, Jacob wrestled with God and won. We learned, however, he did not prevail due to his flesh, he prevailed due to his FAITH. He would not be shaken and would not let go of his faith that God would deliver him.
