"Inventory Your Blessings" - Deut 28: 1-6.

People spend more time cataloging complaints than they do counting their blessings. Think about it, you probably can't even remember all of your blessings -- that's just how good God has been.

Waking up every day knowing you are going to Heaven is a blessing. Even Most of us are better at being faithful than being obedient, but that's where the Grace of God steps in. He loves you in spite of you but rewards and favor are tied to your good works. Let's stop pointing to our issues and problems as excuses for our behavior and instead, start pointing to the Cross.
