James 3:13-18.

I opened this sermon asking the question, '**if you were to paint a picture of perfect peace, what would it look like?**' For some it is difficult to picture what peace looks like because most of their life has been a state of perpetual unrest.

According to a Moody article, over the past 4,000 years, there have been less than 300 years of peace. **It's**
