What will it take for you and I to get to the point

Sometimes people hold back from God because they are unwilling to make a sacrifice. Others hold back because they are unsure of the benefits. But **when you realize that God gave us his first and his best it should cause you to assess how much you are giving back to God.**

Do you give God 'what's left' or 'what's right'? That is the mistake **Ananias and Sapphira** made. They **held back from God when they didn't have to, People change but God**

### Key Sermonic Points

1. *Make sure you know what God expects of you*
2. *Don't hold anything back from God*
3. *Just because Satan fills your plate, doesn't mean you have to eat*

where we hold nothing back from God? Not our time, talent or treasure. Not our giving nor our living. **Others may not know all that God has done in your life but, certainly, YOU KNOW.**

But do you know what God expects, desires and requires of you? Have you immersed yourself in his word to the point where you and God have developed a tight relationship and personal bond? Knowledge is power and **there is no greater knowledge than what has been decreed by the Lord.**
