Pastoral Notes

"The Scatter Effect" Mk 4: 3-9.

The one title that befits every Christian is that of an Evangelist. One who follows the Great Commission of Jesus to "go" out into a world of lost souls to teach them the love and grace of our Lord.

The greatest gift you can give another human being is to expose them to Jesus. Do not underestimate the number of people who don't believe or serve God. Don't be content with your own salvation, but help others to receive the gift of grace God is not focused on your effectiveness but on your faithfulness. He does not measure results, but effort. He is not counting the seeds you grow, only the seeds you sow. Some of what you sow will fall on deaf ears, but know that when you scatter, it does matter. People need to know God loves them.

The Scatter Effect will result in you planting into some good soil. When you do, watch God multiply the harvest because he is a God of increase. God gives us responsibilities so we can

Evangelism is done best when you share the testimony of what God has done in your life. Be like the farmer in our text who scattered seed everywhere he went. As a farmer can't just sow seed outside his front door, you must spend time in the field seeking to sow into the soil of some lost soul's heart.
