

Pastoral Notes

“God’s Looking Out”-
Jeremiah 39:8-14.

No matter where you are or what you are doing, know **that God is looking at you, but also looking out for you.** God never ceases to amaze by his provision, thoughtfulness and timeliness. He shows up when and where he’s needed.

Sometimes we acknowledge the kind deeds of others by saying

away from him. When times are bad don’t stray from God. That is the time to pray harder and get closer. **The enemy of your soul wants to break you financially, spiritually and emotionally. But God wants to be your super-glue to help you hold it all together.** Just as God broke the chains of Jeremiah, he will break the chains that have you bound. **Remember, God is Looking Out.**

Key Sermonic Points

The enemy wanted to:

1. *Burn you but God was looking out*
2. *Break you but God was looking out*
3. *Chain you but God was looking out*

‘good looking out’ but **in reality it’s not “good” looking out, it’s “God”**. It was God who looked after you yesterday and is looking after you today. **He is the reason you rise, work, play and sleep.** When others, including family, spouses and friends, forsake you, God will be there to lift you up.

God shows favor to those with a relationship with him but will turn his back on those who turn
