"I Want It Back" 1Samuel 30: 1-19.

Whatever the Devil has stolen, *claim it* in the name of Jesus; *command it* by the power of Jesus; *declare it* by your faith in Jesus and *decree it* by the blood of Jesus. Seek God to restore what has been taken, whether assets, jobs, family
