'To Bestow a Blessing'-Numbers 6:22-27

God is the source of all that is good and perfect and he alone bestows all true blessings. With the exception of his glory, God has shown a willingness to share with us everything he has including his world, his Word and his Son, our Lord Jesus. He also sees fit to share his blessings.

Sometimes we take for granted some of the many small ways God blesses us. To
