## Pastoral Notes

'Powerful Purposeful Prayer' Lk 11:1; Mt 6:5-13. It can be argued that

prayer is the most powerful weapon Christians have at their disposal. It is a critical habit we all must possess. It is prayer that connects the Holy Spirit, inside of you, with the Heavenly Spirit above you.

Prayer is essential to deepening your relationship with God as **it is reserved for fallen humanity.** God has not given the ability for Angels nor animals to pray,

invited us to pray when he told us to 'ask, seek and knock'. We accomplish all three of these things by prayer.

Jesus taught his disciples to pray, which suggests that prayer is a learned and practiced behavior. The more you pray, the better you get.

The Lord's prayer is a 'model' prayer that teaches four key elements of prayer. Our prayers should include an element of: 1) Adoration (praise) 2) Confession (of sin)

- 3) Thanksgiving and
- 4) Supplication (requests).

## Key Sermonic Points - Prayer should include:

- 1. Adoration.
- 2. Confession.
- 3. Thanksgiving.
- 4. Supplication.

only humans. Prayer is powerful and purposeful because it changes circumstances and people. Some have tried sex, drugs and alcohol to deal with problems but found no results until they resorted to prayer. Just as you have gotten good with 'email', you must become equally good at 'knee-mail'.

Orthodox Jews pray three times a day (Amidah prayers), while devout Muslims pray five times daily (Salat prayers), but what is the quality and quantity of your prayer life? Jesus

Don't worry about your words, just pray what is in your heart for "God knows what you need before you ask". The composition of your words, mean less than the disposition of your heart. End your prayers with Amen which means "so be it" which indicates you in agreement with God.
