'Supersize It' Isa 7: 10-13.

The fast food industry got us accustomed to the idea of supersizing requests, but **God has been in the supersize business for thousands of years.** He gave Abraham a supersized blessing, making him father of many nations. Jesus showed his ability to supersize when he turned 160 gallons of water to wine & fed 5K with 2 fish and 5 loaves of bread. **He supersized the ask of the thief on the cross by not**

got to get to the point where you can pray God sized prayers.

In our text, King Ahaz did not want to ask God for what he needed, even though God wanted to be put to the test. We must not think that testing God is a bad thing. God wants to be tested because he knows he can pass every test. It allows him to prove he **is El-Shaddai, God Almighty.**

You don't need a priest, prophet or other intermediary to get to God. **You have a direct line.** Like

only remembering him but stating, "today you will be with me in paradise".

The bible teaches that **"we have not because we ask not" (James 4:2-3).** If you want to supersize your blessings you've got to supersize your requests. **Go directly to God with your requests.** Don't wait for others to intercede on your behalf. As is it said, 'God bless the child who has his own'. You must have your own prayer life. God may be delaying your response waiting because what you ask is too small of him. **You've**

Jodeci, God is telling you 'come and talk to me, I really want to hear you.' **God knows your problems, he wants to hear your requests. Stop bringing God those value meal, dollar menu requests.** God can supersize your salary, responsibility, & your ability to love, forgive and heal. **If you want God's best, ask him to supersize it.**
