Pastoral Notes

'Can't Come Down' Nehemiah 6:1-4.

When should the work of the Kingdom cease? Never.

When you are doing the work of the Lord, steadily seeking, persistently praying, then you are on the wall for Jesus and you "can't come down".

You may or may not like Gatorade, but few people enjoy the taste of Hatorade. Yet, when you go through life, at some point, you will encounter forces that are in direct opposition to what you stand for. But when you do, **stand firm, keep your faith** and let them know you "can't come down".

kingdom? If you are, when the world (friends, job, family, pleasures) tries to lure you away, tell them 'I'm doing a good work' and I "can't come down".

This world will entice you to go places and do things that don't line up with your faith. When this happens, your simple answer should be "Oh No". No matter how many times they ask, your answer must be the same "Oh No". When some people want to hook up, you need to hang up.

People in distress can't come down because they are **unable**. People in God can't come down because they are **unwilling**. Just as **Jesus was**

Key Sermonic Points

- 1. Haters seldom have the right information
- 2. Don't be afraid to say "Oh No"
- 3. Don't let anyone or anything cause you to put God's work on hold

If you are a Christian, you must make sure you are on the 'wall' and not on the 'fence'. God wants to use you to build his kingdom and mend the gaps and holes that sin has left in this world. God will take your plans and thoughts to another level, making them bigger and better than you could ever think or imagine. God will enlarge your territory so you can be a blessing to those who need to see your light.

Are you on the wall of prayer? Are you a prayer warrior who bombards heaven for the benefit of the saints? Are you on the wall of **servitude**, giving a portion of **your time in ministry** for the furtherance of God's
