

Pastoral Notes

'The Hell Humanity Created?' Romans 1:18-32.

I trust you would agree, with me, that **we are living in troubling times**. When you turn on radio, watch news or tune into social media, bad news is often the news. **People are being deceived and duped into thinking there are no eternal consequences to their actions**. While some people believe that we are living in 'hell on earth', I would submit there is some error in that thinking. The hell that

are not subject to a higher power and, operate as if there is no God. While none of us have ever seen the face of God, he has made his existence clear to us by the things he has created. When you behold the Sun, Moon and Stars, you are beholding the creative power and the existence of God. Because God has made these things clear, the bible states we are without excuse'.

The problems we face: murder, robbery, sexual misconduct, all stem from vain imaginations that are contrary to the Word of God.

Key Sermonic Points

1. *Truth can be suppressed but cannot be changed*
2. *Sin is like a bad loan. You enjoy it now but pay later*
3. *Hell is not a place of wickedness, but a place of torment*

Because of the random and pervasive violence in our country, now, more than ever, you need to make sure you are 'right with God', that your election is sure. You may not be a perpetrator, but you could end up a victim. Our Roman text tells us that, **while the wrath of God has yet to fully come, it is being revealed by the wickedness and godlessness of people**.

People have become hard-hearted and hard-headed. Many live as if they

People try to extinguish the truth of God's word and replace it with their own ideas and thoughts. As a result, we are experiencing the hell humanity created. God allows this but reserves an eternal punishment for such people. That will be in the Hell That God Created.

You know people who don't have a viable relationship with God and whose lives don't line up with his word. **You must be the voice of reason to help them while there is still time**. We want people to
