CALL TO WORSHIP

Leader: A fierce battle is raging around us 24/7. It is the battle of our mind. Throughout the Bible we are encouraged to strengthen, renew and submit our minds, and to "take every thought captive to obey Christ."

Congregation: How do we make our mind, *mind*? It is often disobedient and rebellious, we desire to go one way and it wants to lead us in a direction contrary to God's will. This double mindedness makes us unstable in all our ways resulting in all sorts of chaos and disorder.

ALL: We must make up our mind to follow Jesus, He is the mind regulator and steadies us. Let us be imitators of God, as beloved children, not being conformed to this world, but being transformed by the renewal of our mind so that we might discern what is the will of God in our lives. AMEN.

Scripture Lesson: 2 Corinthians 10:3-6 (NIV)

Leader: 3 For though we live in the world, we do not wage war as the world does.

Congregation: 4 The weapons we fight with are not the weapons of the world. On the contrary, they have divine power to demolish strongholds.

ALL: 5 We demolish arguments and every pretension that sets itself up against the knowledge of God, and we take captive every thought to make it obedient to Christ. **6** And we will be ready to punish every act of disobedience, once your obedience is complete. AMEN.
