



#### **CALL TO WORSHIP**

**LEADER:** My brothers and sisters, let not your heart be troubled, "For the Lord your God is the one who goes with you to fight for you ... to give you victory." We can only achieve that victory by placing our trust in the Lord. Thank the Lord for the promise of victory! Deuteronomy 20:4

**ALL:** We are hard pressed on every side, but *not crushed*; perplexed, but not in despair; persecuted, but not abandoned; struck down, but not destroyed. As we navigate through the challenges of today, let us remind each other that we are overcomers through the power of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. 2 Cor 4:8.9

#### **SCRIPTURE LESSON: ROMANS 8:33-37 NIV**

Leader: 33 Who will bring any charge against those whom God has chosen? It is God who justifies. 34 Who then is the one who condemns? No one. Christ Jesus who died -- more than that, who was raised to life -- is at the right hand of God and is also interceding for us.

**Congregation:** 35 Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall trouble or hardship or persecution or famine or nakedness or danger or sword? **36** As it is written: "For your sake we face death all day long; we are considered as sheep to be slaughtered."

**ALL:** 37 No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us. AMEN
