Call To Worship

Leader: Today are you weary, heavy-burdened and seeking rest for your soul? Let Jesus in. When you encounter Jesus, you encounter His glory!

Scripture Lesson: Psalm 24:1-9 (NIV)

ALL: 8 Who is this King of glory? The Lord strong and mighty, the Lord mighty in battle. **9** Lift up your heads, you gates; lift them up, you ancient doors, that the King of glory may come in. AMEN
