**"WE COME TO PRAISE & WORSHIP THE LORD!"**

**Call To Worship**

**Leader:** We began our Christian journey with a simple prayer of repentance and faith; a heart full of thankfulness for the enormous burden of our sins being lifted. Our spiritual fullness in Christ expands from our foundation of faith. *Col 2:6-7; Eph 4:13;*

**Congregation:** Cultivating a spirit of thankfulness honors God and strengthens our faith. Beyond acts of worship, we can yield our will to God's when we follow the example of Christ, who said, "... not my will, but yours, be done." *Luke 22:42*

**ALL:** When we show our appreciation to God over a few things, He promises to reward us. So then, just as [we] received Christ Jesus as Lord, [let us] continue to live [our] lives in Him ... strengthened in the faith as [we have been] taught, overflowing with thankfulness. *Matt 25:23; Col 2:6, 7*

**Scripture Lesson: Ezra 3:8-11 (NIV)**

**Leader: 8** In the second month of the second year after their arrival at the house of God in Jerusalem, Zerubbabel son of Shealtiel, Joshua son of Jozadak and the rest of the people (the priests and the Levites and all who had returned from the captivity to Jerusalem) began the work. They appointed Levites twenty years old and older to supervise the building of the house of the Lord.

**Congregation: 9** Joshua and his sons and brothers and Kadmiel and his sons (descendants of Hodaviah) and the sons of Henadad and their sons and brothers—all Levites—joined together in supervising those working on the house of God.

**Leader: 10** When the builders laid the foundation of the temple of the Lord, the priests in their vestments and with trumpets, and the Levites (the sons of Asaph) with cymbals, took their places to praise the Lord, as prescribed by David king of Israel.

**ALL: 11** With praise and thanksgiving they sang to the Lord: "He is good; his love toward Israel endures forever." And all the people gave a great shout of praise to the Lord, because the foundation of the house of the Lord was laid. AMEN
