### Call To Worship

**Leader** A plant, flower, vegetable, or fruit which comes out of the ground is different than the seed put in the ground to produce them. Similarly, according to the scripture, our earthly bodies (perishable and susceptible to decay) will experience God's transformative resurrection to a spiritual body unperishable, fit for the spiritual realm. *Luke 20:27-38; 1 Cor 15:42-49*

**Congregation:** Where our soul will ultimately take residence for eternity is dependent on our choice of life or death. After death occurs, our body returns to the ground to await the resurrection. If we've committed our lives to the Lord, the ultimate spiritual makeover awaits us -- the gift of eternal life. *Ecclesiastes 12:7; Romans 6:23*

**ALL:** The Word of God provides strong implications that we will recognize each other in the resurrection. We are to have a body "like his glorious body", and just as He was recognized in His resurrection body so shall we be in ours. *1 Cor 13:12, 15:6; Philipians 3:21; 1 Thess 4:15-18*

### Scripture Lesson: 1 Cor 15:35-41 (NIV)

**Leader: 35** But someone will ask, "How are the dead raised? With what kind of body will they come?"

**Congregation: 36** How foolish! What you sow does not come to life unless it dies. **37** When you sow, you do not plant the body that will be, but just a seed, perhaps of wheat or of something else.

**Leader: 38** But God gives it a body as he has determined, and to each kind of seed he gives its own body. **39** Not all flesh is the same: People have one kind of flesh, animals have another, birds another and fish another.

**Congregation: 40** There are also heavenly bodies and there are earthly bodies; but the splendor of the heavenly bodies is one kind, and the splendor of the earthly bodies is another.

**ALL: 41** The sun has one kind of splendor, the moon another and the stars another; and star differs from star in splendor. AMEN
